**Participation Agreement**

As a Regional/National Team member, I agree to go to ALL tournaments and to uphold the fees for them. If a player chooses not to participate in practices or tournaments, no refund will be given and may result in not playing in matches.

My athlete and I have reviewed the fee schedule of this agreement and understand that all fees must be paid in full regardless of the duration of participation by the individual. I understand that if for some reason the named athlete quits at some point during the 2019-2020 season, we are still liable for all fees until the completion of the season.

**Photo and Video Release**

The undersigned player and parent/guardian hereby authorize JUAB STING VOLLEYBALL CLUB permission to use photographs or videos of the athlete in any and all its publications, including but not limited to all JUAB STING VOLLEYBALL CLUB printed and digital publications. I acknowledge that since my participation is voluntary, I will receive no financial compensation for the use of photo or video. I hereby irrevocably authorize JUAB STING VOLLEYBALL CLUB to edit, alter, copy, exhibit, publish, or distribute the photo or video for purposes of publicizing JUAB STING VOLLEYBALL programs, or for any other lawful purpose.

**Waiver of Liability**

The undersigned player and parent/guardian, hereafter designated as members, agree to accept membership in the JUAB STING VOLLEYBALL CLUB for the 2019-2020 season. Members agree that JUAB STING VOLLEYBALL CLUB, owners, employees, and staff members shall not be liable for any damages arising from personal injuries sustained by the member and/or guest(s), on or about the premises of the said facilities or by participation in events with JUAB STING VOLLEYBALL CLUB.

A member will not be able to participate with JUAB STING VOLLEYBALL CLUB until all the following are signed and turned in:

- 1) Player Contract Agreement 2) Deposit Paid 3) Medical Release Form 4) AAU Membership

**Payment Schedules**

This payment schedule requires the member to pay the team's designated monthly payment which will be due on or before the 15th of each month, beginning November 15, 2019 and must be paid in full by April 15, 2020.

A LATE PAYMENT FEE OF \$25.00 APPLIES TEN (10) DAYS AFTER THE DUE DATE. The player will not be able to participate in tournament play, or practice until they are current with their fees.

# Juab Sting Volleyball Club

## Parent Code of Conduct

As a parent(s)/guardian(s) of a member of the Juab Sting Volleyball Club program, I (we) will conduct myself (ourselves) in the manner described below.

1. I understand that I am paying for my child to learn the skills and concepts of volleyball in an effective and respectful environment. Juab Sting Volleyball Club coaches will provide a role on the team for every player, but my child will not be guaranteed equal playing time in games, matches, or tournaments. Decisions concerning player participation in games and tournaments are solely the responsibility of the coaches.
2. My attendance at matches and tournaments is welcomed and anticipated. I will conduct myself in a respectful manner by:
  - a. Showing appropriate sportsmanship towards all teams, parents, fans, officials, coaches, and staff. I will refrain from using loud or profane language.
  - b. Being patient and supportive with the athletes, regardless of their play.
  - c. Accepting decisions made by the coaches and staff.
  - d. Discontinuing behavior deemed unacceptable at the request of staff, coaches, players, officials, or other fans. If I fail to honor such a request, it is within the rights of the Juab Sting Volleyball Club staff, or any hosting organization's staff, to request that I leave the playing area or the building.
  - e. Refraining from distracting my child, other players, or coaches during competition.
3. If I have a grievance, I will not discuss my grievance during practice times or on game days. I agree to follow the Grievance Policy and Procedures as outlined in the Juab Sting Volleyball Club Handbook. I will abide by the grievance resolution decisions that are made as described in the Handbook's procedures.
4. My child must remain at the competition site until released by the team head coach.
5. I am responsible for my child's conduct. I will be contacted if any problems with my child arise.
6. I agree that I will be financially responsible for all fees assessed relating to my child's participation in Juab Sting VBC programs, plus any penalties resulting from my failure to meet the terms of this agreement as stated in the Juab Sting VBC Handbook and this document. If I remove my child from the Club before the end of the season, I am still obligated to pay my child's full season fee assessment, as the rest of the team cannot be expected to pick up my share of the team's expenses.
7. I agree to the following consequences if my financial balance with Juab Sting VBC is delinquent:
  - a. Juab Sting VBC will not order a clothing packet for my child until my deposit is received.
  - b. My child will not be allowed to participate in December practices if I have not paid the initial deposit.
  - c. My child will be removed from all team rosters if the deposit and December payment are not paid by the end of December.
  - d. If a payment is missed, my child will be suspended from all practices and tournaments until the balance is cleared.
  - e. I agree to pay all late fees as a result of delinquent payment(s).



## **GENERAL INFORMATION**

Welcome to the new Juab Sting Volleyball Club!

As a club, we are anxiously looking forward to this club season. Your daughter has the opportunity to improve their skills, work with great coaches and strengthen friendships. Our coaching staff is our strength. All of our coaches will be trained through the Impact Training Program, where they will be instructed in coaching techniques that will produce consistency and excellence. They will also be trained in “Gold Medal Squared” methodologies. The club will work hard to give you and your daughter an exceptional experience. We are committed to excellence!

We hope you will keep this handbook as a reference throughout the season for many of the questions you may have. It is Juab Sting VBC’s hope that this will be a positive and productive volleyball experience for each individual player. Our goal is to further develop volleyball skills for all girls, while encouraging a love for the game.

United States Volleyball is one of the leading amateur sports organizations in the country, providing millions of amateur and professional volleyball players at all age groups and ability levels the opportunity to train and play volleyball.

Juab Sting VBC will teach the latest and best individual techniques, and the finest concepts in team play. Our coaching philosophies are based on the most current and thorough research done by world renowned coaches. We will also help your daughter with improving her mental and technical skills. Our program requires dedication and effort and will give you a chance to compete against many teams and players from all over the state.

All coaches and administration personnel are required to pass a background check and be registered with AAU Volleyball prior to the Club’s tryouts. Background checks are required to be re-administered every two years after acceptance.

Juab Sting VBC will support the philosophy that volleyball skills of individual athletes would be enhanced if these athletes were given the opportunity to train and compete in volleyball on a year-round basis. We will try to provide these athletes with enough volleyball training and competition so that ultimately, we could maximize their opportunity for a volleyball scholarship at the next level, if desired.

The emphasis is on the development of the individual’s volleyball skills while teaching the values of teamwork, responsibility, self-discipline, and self-motivation. While winning is an important team goal, participation by each individual is stressed, with the focus on improvement in performance rather than winning as the ultimate goal. Every effort is made to locate coaches knowledgeable in the sport of volleyball, as we strive to maintain a high level of skill in our training sessions. All coaches will go through on-going training sessions as well as a national certification program.

## **PRACTICES**

Practice schedules will be presented to the coaches and the players, and also posted on the club website. All teams will be starting practices in December and will practice through late April or early May. All teams (12’s – 18’s) will practice twice a week. Practices will be held at JUAB JR HIGH SCHOOL. There may be occasional instances where the high school in-season sport takes priority of gym use and we will move our practice to another facility. In this case, we will do our best to give advance notice.

Team practice times will be finalized after all tryouts have completed. **Every team requires commitment from the players.** Each team will only have 8-10 players, which means **all team members** are needed at **every practice** and **every tournament**. We expect players to organize their time, so that they can take care of their other responsibilities (homework, jobs, school, etc) without interfering with their responsibilities to Juab Sting VBC for practices, tournaments, fundraising activities, etc. **We strongly encourage families not to schedule family trips during a scheduled tournament that would take away a needed player and leave the team in a bind.**

Players and parents must realize that practice is an essential part of the Juab Sting VBC program, and it hurts the whole team when one player misses practices or tournaments. If a player must miss, coaches **must** be notified PRIOR to practice if a player cannot make it. Failure to notify, or missing practices, may result in diminished playing time in tournaments.

Juab Sting VBC plans to add National Team(s) to its roster in the future. At that time our club expects that our National team members will make volleyball their **priority, and take their commitment seriously**. If there are conflicts with school or other activities, we expect serious consideration and commitments. If a player cannot make this commitment, or their family plans to take them away from their commitment, we suggest that the player not participate.

### **PLAYER ELIGIBILITY**

Players will not be allowed to practice until all forms are completed and turned in along with their money deposit. Please bring ALL FORMS & DEPOSIT to the Commitment Meeting that will be held once teams are finalized and selected players commit. This meeting's date and time is TBA.

### **A SPECIAL NOTE FOR FUTURE REFERENCE**

Utah is the only state that does not hold regional tournaments on Sundays, which makes it possible for players in Utah who don't want to play on Sundays to still play club and get to the next level. However, the National tournaments, in which we will participate in the future, are often played on Sundays ( 1-3 Sundays a year.) This will need to be taken into consideration when making your decisions to commit to our programs in the future. Special arrangements can be made, but that will be between the player, the parents, and the coach. Payment for Nationals is a mandatory, should your team qualify. The decision to add a national team(s) to our rosters will depend on how quickly the player's skills reach the top levels.

### **COACHING STAFF**

Juab Sting VBC feels that coaching is the single most important element for your daughter's development in learning volleyball skills. We will always be looking for and training the best coaches possible, who are committed to your daughter's growth in this sport. Because of this, we feel that the coaches should be paid what they are worth.

### **FEE AND PAYMENT SCHEDULE**

Our fees and payment schedule is outlined on our website.

### **DEPOSIT**

The Deposit holds your child's place on the team and is DUE on November 15th, 2019.

### **MONTHLY PAYMENTS**

**DUE ON THE 15th DAY OF EACH MONTH STARTING IN NOV.**

Juab Sting VBC will make every effort to keep the cost of participation as low as possible. The following are some of the expenses: practice facility rental, coaches salaries, uniforms, equipment, regional tournament fees, miscellaneous clerical expenses, accounting and bookkeeping services.

In an extra effort to make club volleyball affordable, we will sponsor team initiated fund-raising activities which will enable players to earn money towards their expenses. Players are also encouraged to seek sponsors for their club expenses.

### **EXTRA EXPENSES**

In the future, players who participate on certain Juab Sting VBC teams (primarily the National teams) may have some extra expenses related to additional tournaments or travel not included in the Club budget and basic Club fee. These extra charges will be billed the month before the event is to occur.

### **CLUB FEES**

Fees are non-refundable because they are based on the Club's expenses and the total number of players in the Club. A payment schedule has been established to allow the fee paid over a period of time, rather than entirely at the beginning of the season. The Club reserves the right to require payment in full if a player's fees are consistently not paid when due. Club Fees are posted on our website.

Monthly payments are due on the 15th of each month starting in December. Please note that club fees include the ENTIRE SEASON, whether your daughter wishes to complete the season or not (subject to the discretion of the Director).

1. In order for the Club to maximize its efficiency in preparing for the club season (ordering uniforms, sending Tournament entry fees, reserving and paying for practice facility rental, etc.) it is necessary for us to collect the deposit upon acceptance. (Please read over this Parent Manual carefully before attending the parents meeting. We will answer questions that you might have, concerning your decision about joining our Club. If it is not possible for you to pay the deposit amount by the parents meeting, please contact email April Parady at [juabstingvolleyball@gmail.com](mailto:juabstingvolleyball@gmail.com) to make arrangements for payment.
2. Monthly payments are due by the 15th day of each month. Late charges of \$25.00 will be assessed to your account if payment is not received ten days after the due date. Player will also be held out from participating in practices and tournaments until players fees are current.
3. Clothing orders will not be placed until the deposit has been paid. Delinquent accounts will have further consequences including your athlete being suspended from practice, games, and potential removal from all club rosters.

### **CLUB COMMUNICATIONS**

Information regarding Club activities will be posted on our website ([www.juabstingvolleyball.com](http://www.juabstingvolleyball.com)), our Instagram (@juabstingvolleyball), and through team group texts. Some changes may be expected. Exact tournament locations and times for each individual team will be available the week before the tournament. The local AAU web site lists all tournament information and can be viewed for schedules and starting times.

In addition, the Club will organize a communication system based upon each team having a "team parent" who assumes communication and organizational responsibilities. We encourage the parents of the team members to take initiative in organizing who will be the team parent(s). It is helpful to have a least two team parents to share this responsibility to contact another member of the team or team parent to obtain the needed information. You may also access all practice schedules on the Club's web site and tournament schedules, along with tournament site locations on the local AAU website.

### **INSURANCE COVERAGE**

Each participant is expected to have her own medical insurance coverage which will be the primary insurance to be relied upon in the event of injury during a Club activity. Once registered with the AAU Volleyball, participants are covered by the AAU's sport accident policy on a secondary coverage basis while participating in scheduled, supervised, and approved activities such as practice sessions, games, fundraising activities and tournaments. If a player has sustained an injury in a Club activity, the coach

should be notified as soon as possible. If an injury appears serious enough to require a doctor, medical care should be sought immediately. Parents should make a claim for medical expenses to their family medical insurance carrier first. The AAU's coverage is secondary.

## **PARENTAL PARTICIPATION**

Juab Sting VBC needs and encourages parental participation. Many parents find trips to tournaments very enjoyable. At some future national major events, parents are needed to help with chaperoning, transportation, laundry, etc. Please notify your daughter's coach, or the Club Director if you are interested in becoming a team parent. All chaperones will have to complete a background check and register with AAU Volleyball prior to participating with the team and girls, and being named a team parent.

## **RULES AND REGULATIONS OF JUAB STING VBC AND GRIEVANCE POLICY AND PROCEDURES**

- 1) When you have a complaint regarding your daughter, we expect you to use the following steps to solve the problem:
  - 1) The **athlete** should speak with the coach first.
  2. The parent and athlete should speak with the coach.
  3. If the issue is not remedied, the parent and athlete should meet with the coach and the Club Director.

\*Players or parents not complying with this procedure risk expulsion from the club.

2) Parents and/or players are expected to call the coach to set up a meeting time away from tournament or practice site. We do not feel it is advantageous for either parent or coach to discuss decisions at practice or tournaments. We also do not think it is productive for parents to call coaches with concerns after a practice or tournament. Parent should contact coach to set up a time to meet. If a coach is approached during a tournament, please be advised that the coach has been instructed to terminate the conversation and walk away. We will not tolerate hostile, aggressive confrontations to any of the coaching staff, or towards other athletes and/or other parents. If this type of behavior does happen, the person involved and the athlete will be dismissed from the club with no refund of the participation fee.

3) The recommended meeting times for parents to speak with the coach is a scheduled time either before or immediately following practice. Please call the Club Director to arrange that time.

4) It is not appropriate for athletes, or parents, to approach other parents or athletes regarding any problems they may be having with the coach, or any coaching decisions. This type of behavior is rarely positive and not effective for the athlete or the team. There are times when everyone is wondering about substitutions, playing time, etc., and we know that in a competitive team sport like volleyball, not everyone is going to be happy all of the time. We would simply ask that should you hear complaining from any person, whether it is at tournaments, carpooling, or at practice, that you ask the person to call the coach or the Club Director and not air their grievances with you.

5) Juab Sting VBC does not have the philosophy of giving equal playing time during tournaments for the future National Teams. Playing time is determined by the performance of the athletes and is left to the discretion of their coach.

## **PLAYER AND PARENT BEHAVIOR**

Belonging to Juab Sting VBC is a privilege and should not be construed as a right. This privilege can be revoked at the discretion of the Club Director. The Club should not, has not, and will not tolerate players or parents who behave in a manner which is disruptive or detrimental to the Club and its function.

## **PLAYER BEHAVIOR**

Each player, as a condition to Club membership, agrees to abide by the following rules:

1) Player Code of Ethics: A player is not merely an individual; a player also represents both the team and the Club. A player's conduct reflects not only the coach's training, but the philosophy of the entire Club as well. A player's actions, because a player is a leader, must therefore be without reproach.

2) A player should:

- a. Participate as a member of a unit, showing for the team effort.
- b. Be concerned primarily with playing, leaving control of other people at an event to the appropriate officials.
- c. Show respect for others, the coaches, and the officials.
- d. Realize that successful sportsmanship at a game depends, to a large measure, on a player's actions. Thus a player is courteous on the court as well as on the bench.
- e. Make every honest effort to win a contest, but avoid deliberate actions which could cause harm to other players.
- f. Maintain acceptable standards of personal appearance.

### **PARENT BEHAVIOR**

The Club recognizes and is understanding of parent emotions related to competitive sports. The major issues which arise relate to team placement of players, playing time, and criticism of coaching decisions and behavior. Coaching decisions are not subject to parental interference. Parents may make inquiries for clarification, but should not confront the coach on a disagreement. Coaches are not obligated to take abuse which may be acceptable in other organizations. If a coach's behavior is demeaning or detrimental to the welfare of a player, the parent may submit the issue to the Club Director.

### **CLUB DISCIPLINE**

Club discipline is based upon what is best for the player, and in some cases, the Club. The coach is the primary focus of control for discipline. At this level, discipline can remain informal and at a low profile. If it is determined by the coach that steps taken have not remedied the problem, the Club Director may be consulted for assistance.

### **APPEAL CLUB DIRECTOR'S DECISION**

Disputes regarding policy and instructions/directions covered in this handbook are final. However, Appeals are accepted by the Club Director up to 5 days after a decision has been made. The Appeal must be in writing.

### **TOURNAMENT GUIDELINES**

While not an all inclusive list, the following guidelines may be useful:

1. The teams who perform best at the end of the day are the teams who have reserved, or replenished their energy levels during the day. It is important that players maintain their energy levels by consuming food or drink throughout the day. Take snack foods that are nutritional and high in carbohydrates. Take natural sugar items and lots of fruit. Do not eat candy bars or carbonated drinks during competition. Save these until after the game. Bring Gatorade and a jug of water. Nutritional snacks are important because it is not always known how much time is in between matches. There may be time for a snack only and not a meal.

Your coach will determine if there is time for a meal or snack. Stay together until it has been determined how long you have until you play again and what the TEAM is to do. Never leave the gym area without getting permission from the coach. Many families choose to take along an ice chest with drinks and food for their meals, particularly lunch time. It is also a good idea to carry sandwich supplies. Some days get long and buying fast food gets expensive. Again, if a parent isn't accompanying their daughter, they should coordinate food.

2. We recommend you carry a blanket to rest on. Also, bring some folding chairs. In some gyms there are bleachers. In others you can bring in a folding chair and in others you CANNOT bring in chairs. Please check with the gym supervisor regarding the specific site directions.

3. Please respect and follow all rules of the gyms we play and practice in. There is NO FOOD OR DRINKS ALLOWED IN MOST GYMS. Please clean up after yourself – DO NOT LITTER!! Remember,

do not do anything that would jeopardize your team getting a penalty because you did not follow the rules.

4. While at a tournament, the players are encouraged to stay together in the gym or immediately outside the gym area. They may bring blankets and small games or homework to keep occupied. The girls need to rest and be mentally and physically prepared for their next match.

5. It is a good idea to pack a small personal bag for distance tournaments. Include toiletries as well as Tylenol and Ibuprofen. It seems to be something that the girls ask for often and other parents do not like to hand these pills out to someone other than their own daughters.

6. Players and parents shall adhere to specifications of the Code of Conduct at all times while representing Juab Sting VBC.

7. During tournaments when they are not playing in a game, teams are to stay together in one area. But teams are encouraged to support other Juab Sting VBC teams that might be playing in the same venue by watching their games and cheering them on.
